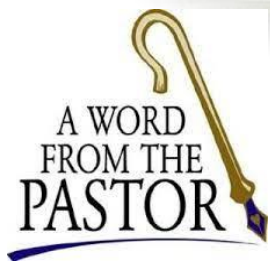

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

If Luther was right, that the true treasure of the church is the gospel — “the most holy gospel of God’s glory and grace” — and if this is the kind of treasure that a person would sell all their possessions to obtain (Matthew 13:44), the kind of treasure that calls for public celebration when it’s found (Luke 15:9), the kind of treasure that means more than any human achievement (Philippians 3:8), then we are in for the adventure of a lifetime together. It’s a treasure hunt — yet a hunt where the treasure isn’t hidden from us but given to us: constantly, abundantly, lovingly, by Jesus.

I’m humbled and delighted to be joining Holy Trinity Lutheran Church — you, my compatriots and siblings — in the adventure of the gospel. It’s a challenging time for the Christian church and for Christian faith. To live, to worship, to bear witness to the world, in accordance with God’s truth in Christ: these are by no means encouraged by our culture or profitable in the eyes of the elite. But the Lord, in mercy, has given us to one another, and, in our being with one another, to our neighbors and our friends, to our colleagues and our adversaries, in order to say with words and deeds: “Jesus is King! This is the good news that you were created to know!”

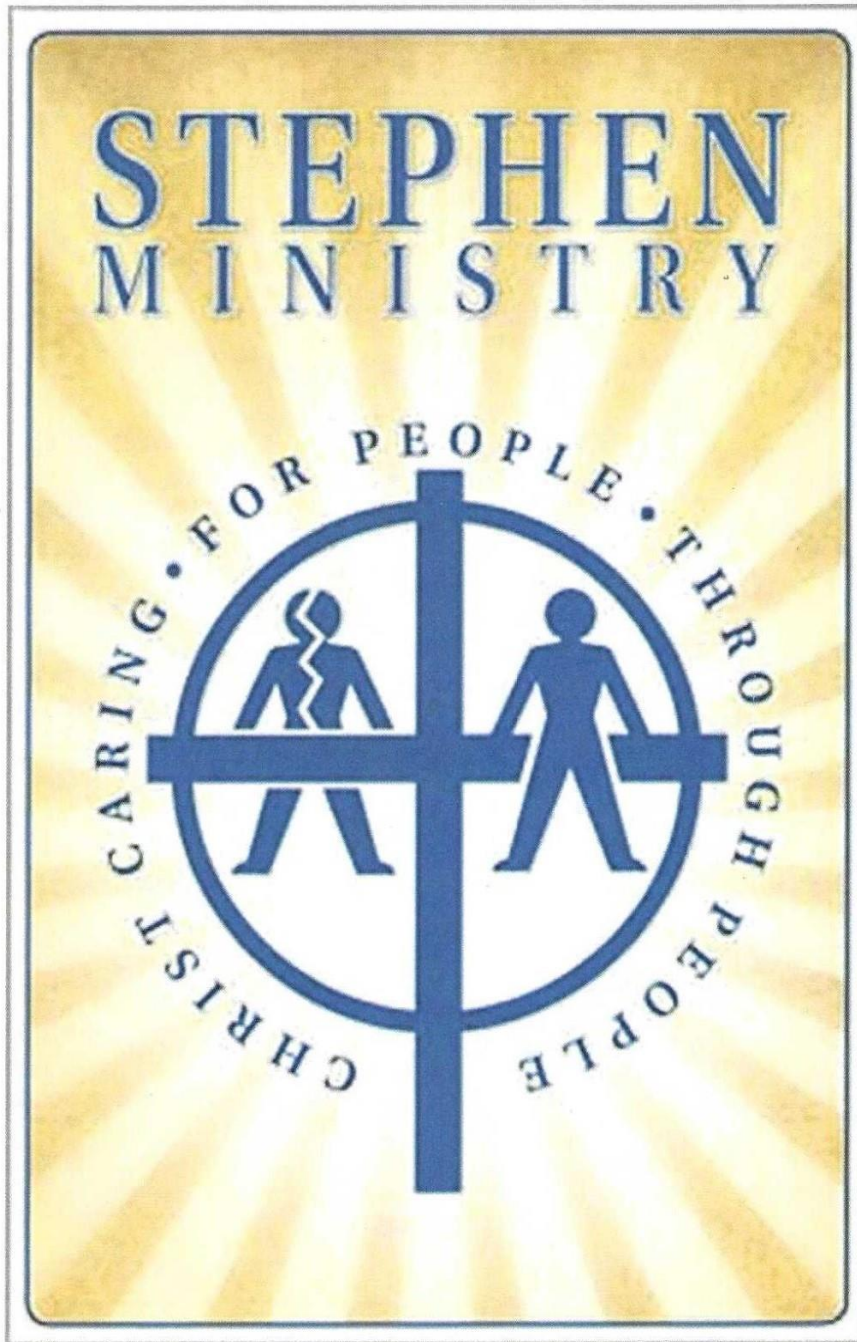

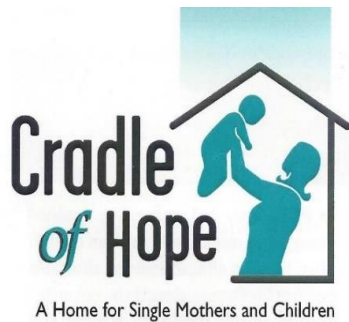


NOTES OF THANKS

Summer Collection for Christ's Home

Highlights from the Operation Christmas Child Connect Conference

Attended by Rosemary Hinkle

We can all be the beautiful feet of Jesus.



- Shoeboxes not only bring children to Jesus, but also they enable church planting. There is a huge multiplication effect of bringing people to Jesus in families and communities where shoeboxes are given to children.
- 151,000 outreach events were held in 2021 to give out 10.1 million shoeboxes. Four million children were enrolled in *The Greatest Journey* Bible course.
- Over the last seven years, shoeboxes were taken to 700 unreached people groups where under 2 percent and often no one knew Jesus. In 2021, 143 such groups representing 10,000 children were reached with shoeboxes and *The Greatest Journey*. The goal over the next five years is to carry shoeboxes and the Gospel to 1,000 unreached people groups.
- The 200,000,000th shoebox will be collected this year. Look for postings on social media.

A religion limited to the sanctuary, that does not go to the streets, is not a religion.

What Is A Quality Shoebox? Every shoebox should be FULL, FUN, and have a WOW item. Volunteers prefer not to have to improve boxes at processing centers where the kinds of items needed to complete boxes are not always available. Items should be made to last and not so cheap that they break the first or second time a child begins to enjoy them. It is highly recommended that one includes a note or letter. Quality shoebox gifts help to build a quality platform for sharing the Gospel.

Why New Suggested Donation

Samaritan's Purse has not been exempt from supply chain difficulties, increased transportation costs (projected to possibly double this year), and inflated paper and printing costs, to name a few. After much prayer, it was decided to raise the suggested donation per box by \$1 to \$10. This is only the third increase in 30 years of distributing shoeboxes; this decision was not made lightly. Samaritan's Purse can only ship more and better shoeboxes if they have finances to support them.

From the US to Ukraine

After the tornado wiped out the town of Mayfield, Kentucky where most people rent and were under or not insured, Samaritan's Purse bought a tract of land and is rebuilding the town with houses and roads. Samaritan's Purse has worked behind the scenes in Afghanistan and is currently also focusing on Ukraine where it has an established network of 3,200 ministry partner churches. Every one of those vetted churches received funds from Samaritan's Purse during the first week of the war. Over the years, more than 11 million Ukrainian children have received shoeboxes. Having a church network foundation in Ukraine enabled Samaritan's Purse to readily bring in emergency services and set up field hospitals.
